Last season, Stillwater won their 1st NYSPHSAA State Championship since 1988, defeating Marcellus 59-50 for the Class B title. Coach Craig Burdo spoke with us about this season's team.

Stillwater lost all starters and players who played significant roles in their success: Lukas Lilac, Jaxon Mueller, Thomas McDonough, Carter Wichelns, Kaelen Leak, Brody Burdo, James Cocozzo, and Shea Brown.

To fill this void, Coach Burdo will rely on returning reserves and players up from a strong JV. Potential starters are Jr. PG Mason Wagner – Elite shooter (reserve on last year's team), Jr. PF John Williams – Tough, physical scorer, Jr. Guard Cody LaFountain – Slasher, good shooter, Jr. Guard Aidan Callanan – Athletic, physical player, and Fr. Forward Rocco Schneller- Smooth scorer, good rebounder.

Others who should play key roles are Jr. Forward Ryan Brown – Solid offensive player, can score from anywhere, Jr. Guard Kaden Burdo - Long defensive player, good rebounder, capable shooter, Jr. Forward Justin Putnum – Solid fundamental player, Great passer and rebounder, Sr. Guard Landen Staie – Aggressive defender, Sr. Forward Matt Lutz – Long Athletic player, and Jr. Forward Caleb Vacula Adams with Sr. Guard Jack Stewart and Jr. Guard Nick Rugani rounding out the team.

Key games on their schedule are 1/14 @ Mechanicville, and 12/13 & 1/24 vs Greenwich.

Despite all the losses, Coach Burdo is optimistic about this year's team; "We lost almost all of the scoring and minutes from last year's team. We will be a very young, inexperienced team at the varsity level. The roster has a lot of guys that have seen success on the basketball court. We bring up a bunch of guys from a very successful JV team (16-3 last year). When added to the few returning players, we should be very competitive in the WASAREN league."
